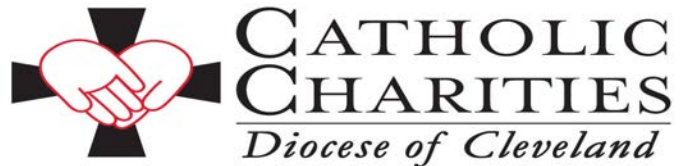
CONGRATULATIONS!
