FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

This weekend we celebrate Memorial Day. This is a time we remember all those who have given their lives for this country. Some of these brave men and women died while on active duty in the midst of gunfire, bombs and snipers. You and I cannot even begin to imagine what it was like unless you were a soldier. There is nothing we can say or do that would take away the pain but try to express our sincere gratitude to the families of those who lost parents, spouses, children and friends all so that we may live in freedom and peace.

We also remember today those men and women who took time out of their lives to enlist in the armed services. SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Eugene de Mazenod was born in France on August 1, 1782. Early in life he experienced the upheaval of the French Revolution. Nonetheless, he entered the seminary, and following ordination he returned to labor in Aix-en-Provence. That area had suffered greatly during the Revolution and was not really a safe place for a priest.

Eugene directed his ministry toward the poorest of the poor. Others joined his labors, and became the nucleus of a religious community, the Missionaries of Provence. Later Eugene was named Bishop of Marseille. There he built churches, founded parishes, cared for his priests, and developed catechetics for the young.

Later he founded the Oblates of Mary Immaculate, and in 1841 the Oblates sailed for missions in five continents. Pius XI said, "the Oblates are the specialists of difficult missions." After a life dedicated to spreading the Good News, Eugene died on May 21, 1861. He was beatified by Pope Paul VI in 1975. His feast day is May 21st.
