# **ROSARY UPDATE**

#### **NEW SCHEDULE:**

FIRST FULL WEEKEND OF THE MONTH

#### WHY:

The First Five Saturdays Devotion

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On December 10, 1925, Our Lady appeared to Sr. Lucia, one of the Fatima visionaries, in the following way:

"See, my daughter, my Heart encircled by thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment by their blasphenies and ingratitude. Do you, at least, strive to console me. Tell them that I promise to assist at the hour of death with the graces necessary for salvation all those who, in order to make reparation to me, on the First Saturday of five successive months, go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, say five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the ... mysteries of the Rosary."

Jesus then appeared to Sr. Lucia on May 29-30, 1930, and gave her the reason behind the five Saturdays devotion. It is because there are five types of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

First: Offenses against the Immaculate Conception

Second: Offenses against Our Lady's Perpetual Virginity.

Third: Offenses against the Divine Maternity, refusing, at the same time, to receive her as the Mother of mankind.

Fourth: Those who seek publicly to implant, in the hearts of children, indifference, disrespect, and even hatred of their Immaculate Mother.

Fifth: Insults directly against her sacred images.

To make this devotion, for five consecutive first Saturdays of the month, and with the intention of making reparation for the offenses against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, we are asked to:

- 1 Go to Confession (may be 8 days before or after, if you are in a state of grace)
- 2 Receive Holy Communion (can be received at a Sunday evening anticipatory Mass)
- 3 Pray five decades of the Rosary
- 4 Keep our Blessed Mother company for 15 minutes while meditating on one or more of the mysteries of the Rosary.
