CATHOLIC EDUCATION: ACTION ALERT

Attention parents, parishioners, and Catholic school supporters! The state of Ohio is planning its next two-year budget, as it does every other spring, with K-12 education consistently the largest area of spending for our state income and sales tax dollars.

Lawmakers are currently weighing proposals both to substantially increase funding for all of Ohio's public schools and to dramatically increase the availability of school choice scholarships such as EdChoice, which currently provides eligible pupils up to \$5,500 in tuition for grades K-8 and \$7,500 for grades 9-12.
