STATEMENT FROM THE DIOCESE

Fr. Michael Feldtz has met with Bishop Malesic earlier this week to discuss his health and the current parish situation. As a result of that meeting, Fr. Feldtz was granted permission to take an Authorized Leave of Absence - Sick Leave. Bishop Malesic made this leave effective 21 May 2024. An authorized Leave of Absence – Sick Leave is defined as time off from official assignment with permission from the Bishop. Customarily, an authorized Leave of Absence - Sick Leave is granted to provide a time for a priest to focus on health issues without the responsibility of managing the day-to-day duties of pastoring a parish.

The bishop will be appointing an Administrator to oversee the pastoral and sacramental life of the parish and the temporal duties necessary to oversee the dayto-day operation of the parish. In addition, the bishop asked Fr. Feldtz for his resignation from the Office of Pastor for the good of the parish, himself and the Church. Please keep Fr. Feldtz in your prayers.

ST. THOMAS MORE SCHOOL


We have been busy in middle school. Eighth grade took their field trip to Detroit, then sixth and seventh grade toured the Cathedral downtown and Playhouse Square. Each grade enjoyed their trips.

In math students finished out the year learning about geometry concepts. Sixth grade students created geocities where they created maps using shapes we studied and built 3D models of their cities since they were learning about area and volume. Seventh grade planned cities by creating maps of concepts using angles and shapes. Eighth grade created candy boxes to finish up their volume unit.

In science, eight graders learned about circuits and were able to take advantage of the snap circuits in our STEM lab. Seventh grade finished up their ecosystem unit and created creatures to fit into an existing biome and started to learn about the periodic table. Sixth graders were learning about potential and kinetic energy and investigated roller coasters and ramps. Afterwards they created ping pong paper ramps to model each type of energy.
